

## Spotlight on Professional and Business Services

According to the 2008 edition of the National Safety Council's "Injury Facts," the Professional and Business Services sector employed approximately 13.5 million people in 2005. That year, the sector reported 91,840 nonfatal occupational injuries and illnesses involving days away from work.

The Professional and Business Services sector includes legal, accounting, architectural, engineering, computer, consulting, research, advertising, photographic, translation and interpretation, veterinary, and other professional scientific and technical services. Also included are business management, administrative and support activities, and waste management and remediation services.

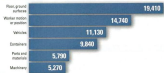
